## Runways

240/050 – 450 meters usable, some loose stones, rough patches - **PLEASE FLY A LOW PASS FIRST TO INSPECT**  
010/190 – 700 meters usable, surface good – **LAND SOUTH OF THE ROAD that INTERSECTS THE RUNWAY!**

## Circuits

To the West on 010/190

To the South on 240/050

1000 feet QNH

Please fly the circuits off the coasts and avoid overflying Homes & Horses on Thorney Island

## Joining

Standard Overhead Join, when descending dead side do this over the water NOT over the homes on the island please.

## Radio

Blind Calls on 135.475 (Safety-Com) FLY - VFR – LOOK OUT of the Window all of the time you are approaching and in circuit
